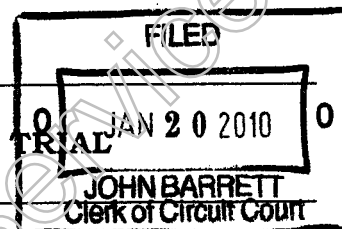

COMPLAINT AND DEMAND FOR JURY TRIAL



NOW COMES the plaintiff, Daniel Fischer, by his attorney, Alan D. Eisenberg, and as and for his complaint against the defendant, alleges and shows to the court as follows:

1. The plaintiff, DANIEL FISCHER, is an adult resident of the State of Wisconsin, residing at N76 W14220 Lari Lou Drive, Menomonee Falls, WI 53051.

2. The defendant, CHARLIE A. VILLANUEVA, is, upon information and belief, an adult resident of the State of Michigan, with an unknown home address, but is presently employed by and through the Detroit Pistons and therefore has a principal place of business located at 6 Championship Drive, Auburn Hills, MI 48326.

3. That on or about February 22, 2008, the plaintiff was located at the "Decibel" bar located at 1905 East North Avenue in the City and County of Milwaukee, State of Wisconsin.

4. That on said date, at said location, the defendant, CHARLIE A. VILLANUEVA, intentionally assaulted and battered the plaintiff, DANIEL FISCHER.

5. That as a direct and proximate result of said assault and battery by the defendant, CHARLIE A. WHEREFORE, the plaintiff requests judgment against the defendant as follows:


- A. For compensatory damages;

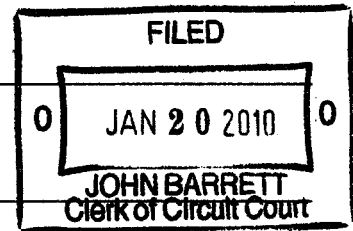


You may have an attorney help or represent you.
