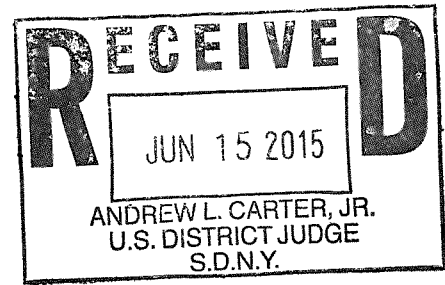

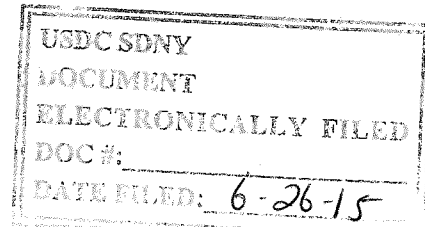

11 CV 7535 (ALC)(GWG)




WHEREAS, a jury trial was held in the above-captioned action before the Hon. Andrew L. Carter, Jr., United States District Judge, commencing on May 11, 2015 and lasting eight (8) days; and

WHEREAS, after due deliberation, the jury returned with a verdict in favor of plaintiff Kathleen Makinen in the amount of Forty-six Thousand One Hundred Dollars and 00/100 (\$46,100.00) and a verdict in favor of plaintiff Jamie Nardini in the amount of One Hundred Five Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$105,000.00); it is hereby

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that plaintiff Kathleen Makinen have judgment against the defendants in the amount of Forty-six Thousand One Hundred Dollars and 00/100 (\$46,100.00) together with attorneys' fees and disbursements; it is further

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that plaintiff Jamie Nardini have judgment against the defendants in the amount of One Hundred Five Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$105,000.00) together with attorneys' fees and disbursements.
