## **EMERGENCY PETITION TO AUTHORIZE**

## **BLOOD TRANSFUSION**

COMES NOW the Broward County State Attorney, by and through undersigned counsel, pursuant to In re: Matter of Patricia Dubreuil, 629 So. 2d 819 (Fla. 1993), and petitions this Court for entry of an Order authorizing Joe DiMaggio Children's Hospital, by and through its treating physician, Eric Abraham Eisner, M.D., to consent to blood transfusions for C. As grounds for this petition, the State would allege as follows:

- 1. C C (Child) is an male with cerebral palsy and right hip dysplasia, who underwent a right hip femoral and pelvic osteotomy on August 7, 2017.
- 2. According to the treating physician, Dr. Eric Abraham Eisner (affidavit of August 9, 2017 attached), since the procedure, the hemoglobin and hematocrit levels have trended down to a current level of 3.9/11.8, and the Child has become tachycardic and lethargic, and has significant palor. It is the opinion of Dr. Eisner, and the pediatric intensivist that the Child needs blood transfusions.



- 3. Without the necessary blood transfusions, the provision of blood products, the condition of the Child will result in stroke, myocardial infarction, or sudden death. There are no other medical alternatives to prevent death or severe morbidity.
- 4. The administration of blood products is necessary to maximize the chances of saving the life of the Child within a reasonable degree of medical certainty.
- 5. The parents of the Child, Kelli and Todd Chamberlin, were notified of the critical nature of the condition of the child, and are refusing the administration of blood products to their child based on their religious beliefs
- 6. Under the circumstances presented The State's interest in protecting the life of Clark Chamberlin is paramount to the convictions of the parents, and this Court should order the necessary transfusions. See, M.N. v. Southern Baptist Hospital, et. al., 648 So.2d 769 (Fla. 1st DCA 1994).

WHEREFORE, the Broward County State Attorney petitions this Court to enter an Order authorizing and directing the blood transfusions recommended for Clark Chamberlin and further authorizing and directing Dr. Eric Abraham Eisner, M.D., or other physicians from Joe DiMaggio Children's Hospital, as treating physicians to perform the blood transfusions based on the emergency circumstances presented in this petition, and to execute all forms necessary to carry out the transfusions.
