


It is further presented that in Harris County, Texas, Lindy Lou Layman, hereafter styled the Defendant, heretofore on or about December 23, 2017, did then and there unlawfully, intentionally, and knowingly damage and destroy tangible property, namely three original paintings and two abstract sculptures, owned by Anthony Buzbee, a person having a greater right to possession of the property than the Defendant and hereafter styled the Complainant, without the effective consent of the Complainant, namely, without any consent of any kind, and the value of the pecuniary loss so inflicted was at least three hundred thousand dollars tore paintings off the wall with her hands, causing damage.
