

1. The Joint Motion is GRANTED.

2. Simpson has knowingly and voluntarily waived any right to seek further
judicial review or appeal of this Court's Final Approval Order or Final Judgment (or
the Ninth Circuit's judgment affirming same), including the filing of a petition for a
writ of certiorari or any other writ that could be filed in connection with the
Settlement.

3. The Court's Final Approval Order and Final Judgment are no longer
subject to further judicial review or appeal whatsoever and, therefore, the Class Action
Settlement is "Final" as of the date of this Order.

4. The Parties and the Settlement are hereby directed to implement the
Agreement according to its terms and conditions and consistent with this Court's Final
Approval Order and Final Judgment.
