The following order is entered in the above matter:

ORDER:

With respect to the depositions of the defendant Alex Jones, the defendant Corey Sklanka, the defendant Wolfgang Halbig, and non-party Kurt Nimmo, as briefed by the parties at ##168,170,173, and 174, the court finds good cause for the depositions to take place. The plaintiffs are entitled to conduct discovery likely to lead to admissible evidence for the purposes of opposing the motions to dismiss. The party depositions should not exceed 5 hours each, and Mr. Nimmo's deposition should not exceed 4 hours (so, maximum of 19 hours total), without prejudice for the plaintiffs to have the time limits re-addressed should there be issues with non-responsive or evasive answers.
