COMPLAINT

Plaintiff Neil Zlozower (“Zlozower” or “Plaintiff”) by and through his undersigned counsel, as and for his Complaint against Defendant Gibson Brands, Inc. (“Gibson” or “Defendant”) hereby alleges as follows:

NATURE OF THE ACTION

1. This is an action for copyright infringement under Section 501 of the Copyright Act. This action arises out of Defendant’s unauthorized reproduction and public display of a copyrighted photograph of Eddie Van Halen of the heavy metal band Van Halen, owned and registered by Zlozower, a professional photographer. Accordingly, Zlozower seeks monetary relief under the Copyright Act of the United States, as amended, 17 U.S.C. § 101 *et seq.*

JURISDICTION AND VENUE

2. This claim arises under the Copyright Act, 17 U.S.C. § 101 *et seq.*, and this Court has subject matter jurisdiction over this action pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1331 and 1338(a).

3. This Court has personal jurisdiction over Defendant because Defendant resides in and/or transacts business in Tennessee.

4. Venue is proper in this District pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1391(b).

PARTIES

5. Zlozower is a professional photographer in the business of licensing his photographs to online and print media for a fee having a usual place of business at 660 N. Sweetzer Avenue, #303, Los Angeles, CCA 90048.

6. Upon information and belief, Gibson is a foreign business corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware, with a place of business 309 Plus Park Blvd, Nashville, TN 27217. Upon information and belief, Gibson is registered with the Tennessee Department of Corporations to do business in Tennessee. At all times material, hereto, Gibson has owned and operated a website at the URL: www.Gibson.com (the “Website”).

STATEMENT OF FACTS

A. Background and Plaintiff’s Ownership of the Photograph

7. Zlozower photographed Eddie Van Halen of the heavy metal band Van Halen (the “Photograph”). A true and correct copy of the Photograph is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

8. Zlozower is the author of the Photograph and has at all times been the sole owner of all right, title and interest in and to the Photograph, including the copyright thereto.

9. The Photograph was registered with the United States Copyright Office and was given registration number VA 1-680-668.

B. Defendant’s Infringing Activities

10. Gibson ran an article on the Website entitled *Flashback: Eddie Van Halen on 1984*. See URL: <https://www.gibson.com/News-Lifestyle/Features/en-us/flashback-eddie-van-halen-on.aspx>. The article featured the Photograph. A screenshot of the Photograph on the article is attached hereto as Exhibit B.

11. Gibson did not license the Photograph from Plaintiff for its article, nor did Gibson have Plaintiff's permission or consent to publish the Photograph on its Website.

CLAIM FOR RELIEF
(COPYRIGHT INFRINGEMENT AGAINST DEFENDANT)
(17 U.S.C. §§ 106, 501)

12. Plaintiff incorporates by reference each and every allegation contained in Paragraphs 1-11 above.

13. Gibson infringed Plaintiff's copyright in the Photograph by reproducing and publicly displaying the Photograph on the Website. Gibson is not, and has never been, licensed or otherwise authorized to reproduce, publically display, distribute and/or use the Photograph.

14. The acts of Defendant complained of herein constitute infringement of Plaintiff's copyright and exclusive rights under copyright in violation of Sections 106 and 501 of the Copyright Act, 17 U.S.C. §§ 106 and 501.

15. Upon information and belief, the foregoing acts of infringement by Defendant have been willful, intentional, and purposeful, in disregard of and indifference to Plaintiff's rights.

16. As a direct and proximate cause of the infringement by the Defendant of Plaintiff's copyright and exclusive rights under copyright, Plaintiff is entitled to damages and Defendant's profits pursuant to 17 U.S.C. § 504(b) for the infringement.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff respectfully requests judgment as follows:

1. That Defendant Gibson be adjudged to have infringed upon Plaintiff's copyrights in the Photograph in violation of 17 U.S.C §§ 106 and 501;

2. That Plaintiff be awarded either: a) Plaintiff's actual damages and Defendant's profits, gains or advantages of any kind attributable to Defendant's infringement of Plaintiff's Photograph; or b) alternatively, statutory damages of up to \$150,000 per copyrighted work infringed pursuant to 17 U.S.C. § 504;
3. That Defendant be required to account for all profits, income, receipts, or other benefits derived by Defendant as a result of its unlawful conduct;
4. That Plaintiff be awarded his costs, expenses and attorneys' fees pursuant to 17 U.S.C. § 505;
5. That Plaintiff be awarded pre-judgment interest; and
6. Such other and further relief as the Court may deem just and proper.

DEMAND FOR JURY TRIAL

Plaintiff hereby demands a trial by jury on all issues so triable in accordance with Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 38(b).
