VERIFIED COMPLAINT

For their Complaint, the Tennessee Democratic Party, Biden for President, Warren for President, Bernie 2020, and Mike Bloomberg 2020 (the "Plaintiffs") aver as follows:

- 1. Plaintiff The Tennessee Democratic Party is a recognized political party and is committed to ensuring that all eligible citizens have the opportunity to vote. All remaining Plaintiffs are campaigns for President of the United States appearing on the Democratic primary ballot in the March 3, 2020, Democratic primary election in Davidson County, Tennessee.
- 2. Plaintiff, The Tennessee Democratic Party, has standing on its own behalf and on behalf of registered voters in this county whose right to vote today is in danger of being irreparably taken away by Defendants. All remaining Plaintiffs have standing because they are campaigns for President of the United States appearing on the Democratic primary ballot in the March 3, 2020

Democratic primary elections in Davidson County, Tennessee. These Plaintiffs will be irreparably harmed if all eligible citizens in Davidson County, Tennessee are unable to cast their ballots in the Democratic primary election.

- 3. Defendant Davidson County Election Commission is the entity that oversees elections in Davidson County, Tennessee, including the election at issue in this lawsuit.
- 4. Defendant Tre Hargett, Secretary of State of Tennessee, oversees election commissions throughout the State of Tennessee, including the election at issue in this lawsuit.
- 5. In the early morning hours of Tuesday, March 3, 2020, a tornado affected large portions of Davidson County. Among other things, these events gave rise to a declaration of emergency from Governor Lee.
- 6. Under Tenn. Code Ann. § 2-3-201(b)(1), "the county election commission shall determine a uniform time for the opening of all polling places in the county," and do so "[a]t least fifteen (15) days before the date of each election."
- 7. Pursuant to that statute, Defendants determined that the uniform time for the opening of polling places within the county would be 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. on March 3, 2020. See Davidson County Sample Ballot (Frank Declaration, Ex. A).
- 8. Defendants delayed the opening of all polls to at least 8:00 a.m. in the county due to inclement and severe weather including at least one tornado that touched ground in Davidson County on or around March 2, 2020.
- 9. As a result of this late opening, at least some Davidson County residents who came to vote between 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. left without being able to vote.
- 10. In addition, at least some Davidson County residents who arrived at or after 8:00 a.m. were unable to vote at their polling location because of power outages and other technical

delays.

- Nashville Mayor John Cooper publicly stated to the news media that out of Nashville's 169 precincts, 15 polling places are diverting voters to alternate locations. *See* List of Polling Location Changes (Frank Declaration, Ex. B). These diversions create confusion among voters and, in some cases, prevent these voters from voting and expressing their support for any of the candidates certified for the ballot in the Tennessee presidential preference primary for the Democratic party. The delayed opening of all polling places until 8:00 a.m. and the diversion of voters to different polling places from polling places that were unable to open occurred on the date of the March 3, 2020 election and not, as required by statute, at least fifteen (15) days before the date of the election.
- 12. Unless immediate injunctive relief is forthcoming from this court, immediate and irreparable harm will likely occur to the federal and state constitutional rights of one or more voters in this county, *i.e.*, their right to vote. Accordingly, to ensure that the rights of eligible Davidson County, Tennessee voters are not irreparably harmed, Plaintiff requests that this Court order Defendants to keep all polls in Davidson County open until 10:00 p.m., three (3) hours after the currently-scheduled time for the polls to close, which is 7:00 p.m. These voters will suffer irreparable harm if they are not provided the full time to vote and sufficient time to vote in light of the natural disaster that hit Davidson County on the eve of today's election.

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, Plaintiff seeks from this Court a restraining order directing Defendants to direct election officials at all polling locations in Davidson County to keep all polls at that polling place open for an additional three (3) hours until 10:00 p.m. to ensure that all persons in line to vote at or before 10:00 p.m. are permitted to vote.
