**STATUS REPORT REGARDING  
SETTLEMENT EFFORTS  
PURSUANT TO THIS COURT'S  
ORDER**

1 TO THE HONORABLE COURT, ALL PARTIES, AND TO THEIR  
2 COUNSEL OF RECORD:

3 Pursuant to the Court’s Minute Orders (Docket Nos. 597, 597), Defendant  
4 County of Los Angeles (the “County”) respectfully submits the following report  
5 advising the Court of the status of the parties’ settlement.

6 In the County’s June 29, 2020 status report (Docket 596), the County advised  
7 the Court that counsel was informed that the normal settlement approval process  
8 would be required for this case even though the procedures and policies at issue in  
9 this case are no longer in place. The County advised the Court that the normal  
10 settlement process required the drafting of attorney-client privileged documents  
11 which would need to be approved by multiple agencies, and Defense counsel advised  
12 the Court that they had seen, and provided guidance and edits to those draft  
13 documents. The County further advised that once those documents were prepared  
14 and approved, the settlement would first be submitted to the County’s Claims Board,  
15 and then to the County’s Public Safety Cluster before being submitted to the County  
16 Board of Supervisors for approval.

17 Counsel is pleased to advise the Court that the settlement documents have been  
18 finalized and approved, the settlement has been submitted to the Claims Board, and  
19 the Claims Board has approved the settlement. The case is now being scheduled for  
20 hearing by the Public Safety Cluster. We have not yet received confirmation for the  
21 date of that hearing, but counsel is hopeful it will be in August or early September.

22 Pursuant to the Court’s May 15, 2020 Minute Order (Docket 595), counsel will  
23 provided an updated settlement approval status in another 45 days.
