**AGREED PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION**

WHEREAS, on November 12, 2020, Plaintiff Xiqui “Bob” Fu (“Plaintiff”) filed his Original Complaint for Tort Damages and Injunctive Relief (the “Complaint”) against the named Defendants, asserting claims for stalking, defamation per se, invasion of privacy, assault, private nuisance, and conspiracy (*see* ECF No. 1);

WHEREAS, on December 31, 2020, Plaintiff filed a Motion and Application for Preliminary Injunction against Defendants, or anyone acting in concert with them, from picketing Plaintiff’s home, approaching within one hundred (100) feet of Plaintiff, his wife, his children, or any China Aid employees, and picketing within fifty (50) feet of points of ingress and egress to China Aid’s business location (*see* ECF No. 33);

WHEREAS, Defendants Guo Wengui (a/k/a Miles Kwok) (“Kwok”), GTV Media Group, Inc. (“GTV”), and Saraca Media Group, Inc., (“SMG,” and together with Guo and GTV, the

“Defendants,” and together with Plaintiff, the “Parties”) assert that they have not picketed Plaintiff’s home, or approached within one hundred (100) feet of Plaintiff, his wife, his children, or any China Aid employees, or picketed within fifty (50) feet of points of ingress and egress to China Aid’s business location, as alleged in the Motion and Application for Preliminary Injunction;

WHEREAS, by January 2021, the protesting at Plaintiff’s home and China Aid’s business location had subsided;

WHEREAS, notwithstanding the foregoing, Defendants agree not to picket Plaintiff’s home, or approach within one hundred (100) feet of Plaintiff, his wife, his children, or any China Aid employees, or picket within fifty (50) feet of points of ingress and egress to China Aid’s business location;

WHEREAS, on January 25, 2021, Plaintiff and Defendants stipulated and agreed to the relief set forth in this Order without any admission by Defendants of wrongdoing or violation of law, in order to avoid the time and expense of litigating the Motion and Application for Preliminary Injunction; and

WHEREAS, upon entry of this stipulated Order, Plaintiff withdraws the Motion and Application for Preliminary Injunction as to Defendants.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Defendants, including their representatives, agents, servants, and employees, are preliminarily enjoined from:

- a. Picketing outside Plaintiff’s home or anywhere else on Bishops Castle Drive in Midland, Texas;
- b. Approaching within one hundred (100) feet of Plaintiff, his wife, and his children; and
- c. Picketing within fifty (50) feet of any point of ingress and egress at the China Aid office property.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff's Motion and Application for Preliminary Injunction (ECF No. 33) is deemed withdrawn without prejudice as to Defendants.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order will expire on June 1, 2021, unless extended by the Court or by agreement of the Parties.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that nothing herein shall constitute a waiver of any jurisdictional challenge that Defendants may have in connection with the Complaint or otherwise in this lawsuit.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order is extendable or terminable by stipulation of the Parties. Neither Defendants nor Plaintiff waive their rights to seek a modification of this Order.
