Dear Leader Schumer and Chairman Carper:

We write to urge you to include at least \$200 million per year for the Pilot Program for Alternative Water Source Grants (33 U.S.C. 1300) in upcoming infrastructure legislation. In the face of unprecedented heat and drought conditions across the Western United States, and growing water resource challenges across the entire country, we must invest now in order to build climate-resilient water infrastructure.

The Alternative Water Source Projects pilot program provides competitive grants to engineer, design, construct, and test alternative water source systems, including water recycling systems and projects that conserve, manage, reclaim, or reuse water resources.

We are facing a climate crisis, and the decisions we make now will have an environmental, economic, and social impact for generations to come. Bolstering water supply reliability and resiliency is critical for regions facing severe drought and other significant challenges, and alternative water source projects, including those for stormwater capture, groundwater recharge, and potable reuse are crucial to this effort.


