

Three Are Arrested On Liquor Charges

Three persons were arrested last night by county police and charged with violating state liquor laws, Chief Julian T. Williams said today.

Estelle Varner, 22, of Union Heights, was arrested by Policemen J. W. Cox and Norwood West when they found her, walking along Cosmopolitan avenue, in Union Heights, with a suitcase containing three jars of illegal whiskey.

Josephine Copley, 18, also of Union Heights, was charged with a liquor law violation when police discovered one jar and three half-pints of liquor at her residence. Alprecious Aiken, 23, was arrested by Sergeant Fred Limehouse and Policeman W. H. Overstreet, who reported finding liquor at a Liberty Hill road establishment.

Appearing before Magistrate Gene Herron today, the Varner woman was ordered to pay a fine of \$25 or serve 30 days, the Copley woman to pay a fine of \$75 or serve 30 days.
