COMES NOW, the Commonwealth, by her Assistant Attorney General, James R. Herring, and moves this Court to *Nolle Prosequi* the above captioned indictments, for the following reasons:

1. In preparation for the scheduled jury trial, the Commonwealth interviewed several witnesses.
