The Defendant above named, DEOBRA DELONE REDDEN, accused by the Clark County Grand Jury of the crime(s) of ATTEMPT MURDER, VICTIM 60 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER (Category B Felony - NRS 200.010, 200.030, 193.153, 193.167 - NOC 50032), BATTERY ON A PROTECTED PERSON RESULTING IN SUBSTANTIAL BODILY HARM, VICTIM OVER 60 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER (Category B Felony - NRS 200.481 - NOC 62402), EXTORTION BY THREAT (Category B Felony - NRS 205.320 - NOC 50619), INTIMIDATING PUBLIC OFFICER (Category C Felony - NRS 199.300 - NOC 52993), BATTERY ON AN OFFICER RESULTING IN SUBSTANTIAL BODILY HARM (Category B Felony - NRS 200.481 - NOC 50218), PERFORMANCE OF ACT OR NEGLECT OF DUTY IN WILFUL OR WANTON DISREGARD OF SAFETY OF PERSONS OR PROPERTY RESULTING IN SUBSTANTIAL BODILLY HARM OR DEATH (Category C Felony - NRS 202.595 - NOC 51540), BATTERY ON A PROTECTED

PERSON (Gross Misdemeanor - NRS 200.481 - NOC 50221), BATTERY BY PRISONER (Category B Felony - NRS 200.481(2)(F) - NOC 50229) and UNLAWFUL ACT RELATED TO HUMAN EXCREMENT OR BODILY FLUID (Category B Felony - NRS 212.189 - NOC 55114), committed at and within the County of Clark, State of Nevada, on or about the 3rd day of January, 2024, as follows:

COUNT 1 - ATTEMPT MURDER, VICTIM 60 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER

did willfully, unlawfully, feloniously and with malice aforethought attempt to kill JUDGE MARY KAY HOLTHUS, who is 60 years of age or older, to wit: during his rendition of sentence and once he knew she was about to sentence him to prison, did leap over defense counsel table into the well of the courtroom, thereafter rushing towards the judicial bench and jumping over it "superman" style directly into JUDGE MARY KAY HOLTHUS's judicial space, landing directly on top of her and immediately attacking JUDGE MARY KAY HOLTHUS by grabbing her, pulling her hair, placing his hands around her throat and/or hitting her on the head by manner and means unknown.

COUNT 2 - BATTERY ON A PROTECTED PERSON RESULTING IN SUBSTANTIAL BODILY HARM, VICTIM OVER 60 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER

did willfully, unlawfully and knowingly use force or violence upon the person of another, to wit: JUDGE MARY KAY HOLTHUS, who is 60 years of age or older and is a protected person employed as an 8th Judicial District Court Judge, while JUDGE MARY KAY HOLTHUS was performing the duties of a 8th Judicial District Court Judge, which defendant knew, or should have known, that JUDGE MARY KAY HOLTHUS was an 8th Judicial District Court Judge, by grabbing her, pulling her hair, placing his hands around her throat and/or hitting her on the head by manner and means unknown, resulting in substantial bodily harm to JUDGE MARY KAY HOLTHUS.

COUNT 3 - EXTORTION BY THREAT

did willfully, unlawfully, feloniously and knowingly, with the intent to influence the action of any public officer, to wit: JUDGE MARY KAY HOLTHUS, whether or not the purpose is accomplished, threatens directly or indirectly to injure a person, to wit: during his

rendition of sentence and once he knew she was about to sentence him to prison, did leap over defense counsel table into the well of the courtroom, thereafter rushing towards the judicial bench and jumping over it "superman" style directly into JUDGE MARY KAY HOLTHUS's judicial space, landing directly on top of her and immediately attacking JUDGE MARY KAY HOLTHUS by grabbing her, pulling her hair, placing his hands around her throat and/or hitting her on the head by manner and means unknown.

COUNT 4 - INTIMIDATING PUBLIC OFFICER

did willfully, unlawfully, and feloniously, directly or indirectly, address any threat or intimidation to a public officer, namely JUDGE MARY KAY HOLTHUS, a Judicial Officer, with intent to induce her, contrary to his/her duty to do, make, omit or delay any act, decision or determination, with use of physical force, or the immediate threat of such force, to wit: during his rendition of sentence and once he knew she was about to sentence him to prison, did leap over defense counsel table into the well of the courtroom, thereafter rushing towards the judicial bench and jumping over it "superman" style directly into JUDGE MARY KAY HOLTHUS's judicial space, landing directly on top of her and immediately attacking JUDGE MARY KAY HOLTHUS by grabbing her, pulling her hair, placing his hands around her throat and/or hitting her on the head by manner and means unknown.

COUNT 5 - BATTERY ON AN OFFICER RESULTING IN SUBSTANTIAL BODILY HARM

did willfully, unlawfully and knowingly use force or violence upon the person of another, to wit: J. CABRALDA, who was performing the duties of a peace officer employed with the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department, which defendant knew or should have known that J. CABRALDA was an officer, by punching and/or kicking and/or pushing said officer, said acts resulting in SUBSTANTIAL BODILY HARM.

COUNT 6 - PERFORMANCE OF ACT OR NEGLECT OF DUTY IN WILFUL OR

WANTON DISREGARD OF SAFETY OF PERSONS OR PROPERTY RESULTING IN

SUBSTANTIAL BODIILY HARM OR DEATH

did then and there willfully, unlawfully, and feloniously perform an act in willful or wanton disregard of the safety of persons or property, in the following manner, to wit: by jumping over defense counsel table into the well of the courtroom, thereafter rushing at the judicial bench and leaping over it "superman" style to attack and/or kill the judge causing Marshal S. BRANDON and others to respond in defense of Defendant's actions towards the judge, resulting in substantial bodily harm or death to Marshal S. BRANDON.

COUNT 7 - BATTERY ON A PROTECTED PERSON

did willfully, unlawfully and knowingly use force or violence upon the person of another, to wit: MICHAEL LASSO, who is a protected person employed as an 8th Judicial District Court Law Clerk to the Honorable Judge Holthus, which defendant knew or should have known that MICHAEL LASSO was an 8th Judicial District Court Law Clerk, by grabbing and/or pushing MICHAEL LASSO.

COUNT 8 - BATTERY BY PRISONER

did willfully, unlawfully, feloniously, and knowingly use force or violence upon the person of another, to wit: Officer C. BOU, by spitting on Officer C. BOU, defendant at the time of the offense, being a prisoner in lawful custody or confinement.

<u>COUNT 9 - UNLAWFUL ACT RELATED TO HUMAN EXCREMENT OR BODILY</u> <u>FLUID</u>

did then and there willfully, unlawfully, feloniously and intentionally use, propel, discharge or spread any human excrement or bodily fluid consisting of saliva, with the intent to have the excrement or bodily fluid come into physical contact with any portion of the body of another person or under circumstances in which the excrement or bodily fluid was reasonably likely to have come into contact with any portion of the body of another person, to
