This matter came before the Court upon the motion of Plaintiff RPAC Racing, LLC d/b/a Legacy Motor Club (“Plaintiff” or “Legacy”) for a preliminary injunction, seeking to enjoin Defendant Rick Ware Racing, LLC (“RWR”) from selling, leasing, encumbering, and/or otherwise transferring any interest in NASCAR Charter Number 27 (“Charter No. 27”) during the course of this litigation. A hearing was held on April 30, 2025 in Mecklenburg County Superior Court (“Hearing”), with counsel for all the parties in attendance. The Court, upon hearing the arguments of counsel, and having reviewed the Verified Complaint and Motion for Temporary Restraining Order and Preliminary Injunction, affidavits, and other documents provided by the parties, and being otherwise fully informed and advised, finds that the Plaintiff has not established the factual predicates and legal elements necessary for the issuance of a preliminary injunction. Accordingly, the Court hereby rules as follows:


IT IS ORDERED that Plaintiff’s request for a preliminary injunction seeking to enjoin Rick Ware Racing, LLC from selling, leasing, encumbering, and/or otherwise transferring any interest in NASCAR Charter Number 27 (“Charter No. 27”) during the pendency of this

litigation is hereby **DENIED**, and that the TRO originally entered by this Court on April 9, 2025 is also hereby immediately **DISSOLVED**.
