COUNT I

BATTERY RESULTING IN BODILY INJURY

I.C. 35-42-2-1(c)(1) and I.C. 35-42-2-1(d)(1)
A CLASS A MISDEMEANOR

COUNT II

UNAUTHORIZED ENTRY OF A MOTOR VEHICLE

A CLASS B MISDEMEANOR

COUNT IV

BATTERY RESULTING IN SERIOUS BODILY INJURY

I.C. 35-42-2-1(c)(1) and I.C. 35-42-2-1(g)(1)
A LEVEL 5 FELONY

On this date, the undersigned Deputy Prosecuting Attorney of the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit, being duly sworn on his/her oath (or having affirmed), says that in Marion County, Indiana

COUNT I

On or about October 4, 2025, MARK SANCHEZ did knowingly touch P. T. in a rude, insolent, or angry manner by throwing or shoving P. T. resulting in bodily injury, that is: a laceration to P. T.'s face, or pain;

COUNT II

On or about October 4, 2025, MARK SANCHEZ did enter the motor vehicle of P. T., to-wit: a 2026 Freightliner box truck, knowing that he did not have permission of P. T., to enter said vehicle and MARK SANCHEZ did not have a contractual interest in said vehicle;

COUNT III

On or about October 4, 2025, MARK SANCHEZ was found at a public place or a place of public resort, in a state of intoxication caused by the person's use of alcohol or a controlled substance (as defined in IC 35-48-1-9); and further, MARK SANCHEZ endangered his own life, or the life of P. T., or breached

the peace, or harassed, annoyed, or alarmed P. T.;

COUNT IV

On or about October 4, 2025, MARK SANCHEZ did knowingly touch P.T. in a rude, insolent, or angry manner, by throwing or shoving P.T. resulting in serious bodily injury, that is extreme pain;

all of which is contrary to statute and against the peace and dignity of the State of Indiana.
